Hazard	Risk Element	Possible Actions	Action recommended	Review / Comments
Falling	Low	Holds not higher than 3ft from ground Safety checks.	Conduct safety checks of wall (see log)	
Bruising	Medium	Clear instructions on how to climb. Give instructions on what to do if you slip or fall. Spotters	Ensure all participants are wearing appropriate clothing. Make participants aware of how to react when falling. Make participants aware of how to spot	
Loosing hand grip or foot hold	Medium	Give instructions on how to minimise possibility of slipping. Wearing appropriate footwear. Inspect holds for wear.	Instruct students on basic climbing techniques. Inspect wall holds for wear annually (see Log)	
Impact on falling	Medium	Ensure area at base of climbs conforms with safe landing policies.	Place a minimum of 12 inches (300mm) of wood chips at base of all walls. Wood Chips upgraded every 6mths as per log
