INSTRUCTIONS

There are four activities you can run.

WORD ACTIVITIES(8-14 YEAR OLDS)

Depending on the skill levels of the group, do a few word activities for 10 minutes to get the group use to tree terminology.

LEAF HUNT (6-14 YEAR OLDS)

Get the participants to collect as many different types of leaves as possible. Identify the leaves using the leaf hunt/twig identification sheets.



BARK RUBBINGS (10-14 YEAR OLDS)

Using A4 Sheets of paper and a pencil (materials not supplied) create bark rubbings that you can use to create your own tree bark identification chart.

WOODLAND ART (6-10 YEAR OLDS)

Aimed more at 8-10 year olds - use the leaves you have collected to create some simple art work. (Glue Sticks / Paper not supplied)
